April Meeting Featured NOAA and the 2005 Hurricane Season, Plus Frank Kennedy's Superb Chili

About 36 members and 4 guests attended the April meeting of VPS. Our guest speaker was Tim Osborn, Navigation Manager, Eastern Gulf of Mexico Region for NOAA and Regional Coordinator for NOAA's Coastal Programs. He is also the Regional Manager for Coastal Charting and Tide and Water Level and Geodetic Programs for Louisiana and along the Northern Gulf Coast. Tim traveled from his base in Lafayette, Louisiana to Birmingham to present his program to our squadron.

Tim provided the audience with a lively presentation on the important work NOAA supplied along the northern Gulf coast during the 2005 hurricane season. He explained that NOAA is just beginning to provide mariners with information on waterways currently being surveyed after the devastating effects of Hurricanes Katrina, Rita and Wilma. He also spoke to the group about marine navigation and the various chart products that NOAA is supporting - paper and electronic raster and vector charts. Following the talk, Tim gave away a number of NOAA's official Gulf coast paper charts and answered questions from the audience.

Prior to the program, everyone enjoyed a special meal prepared by VPS members Frank and Diane Kennedy. The menu featured Frank's home made chili with all the toppings, authentic hot tamales and Diane's delicious cole slaw. Lemonade and sweet sopapillas, a Mexican desert pastry, rounded out the meal. Many thanks to Frank and Diane for their generous and tasty contribution.
